











City Tour, and visit the Panama Canal!

Tour Highlights:

✓ We will visit the City's most important places (which make this City a unique one, with so many contrasts). We will stop at the Colonial City (built in 1673), and pass the modern-day Financial Banking Center and commercial shopping area. Afterwards, we will drive on the Causeway (which joins the mainland with the 3 islands that were heavily-fortified wartime U.S. military defense outposts at the Pacific Ocean entrance of the Canal). Weather permitting, we will go to the top of Ancon Hill (the City's highest elevation point). Here we will have a bird's-eye-view of the Capital City, as well as Miraflores Locks in the distance. We will visit the Panama Canal 's "Miraflores Visitors' Center".
